1.

System capacity is limited to 10kw or 120% nameplate for residential.

2.

System capacity is limited to 25kw or 120% nameplate for commercial.

3.

SIEA does not require a REC meter.

4.

SIEA currently offers no rebates or financial incentives for renewables.

5.

SIEA follows current electric code for safety standards and installation.

6.

SIEA's yearly "true-up" for excess generation is done in May and is at current avoided costs (can range from year to year) 2017 was @7.51 cents.

7.

SIEA requires NEM application before any work is done along with a \$200 application fee.

8.

After inspection by local authorities SIEA will reach out to the member for final document signing (NEM), usually done at closest area office for the member.

9.

SIEA will likely follow up with member if system appears to be sized improperly or with any other concerns.

10.

SIEA's applicable access charge can not be offset with excess production and is currently at \$20 per month for residential.

11.

SIEA requires the member to carry minimum General Liability insurance of:

- a. Bodily Injury @ \$300,000
- b. Property Damage @ \$300,000
